Further Easing of COVID-19 Restrictions

Based on the latest update from Government as regards the further relaxation of social distancing measures I am pleased to report that we are now in a position to open up the Swimming Pool from Thursday 1st April onwards. However the opening of the Swimming Pool comes with certain conditions;

- Swimming Pool user capacity is restricted to 30% (For details of the rules on user capacity please see below).
- The Children's Pool(s) remain closed.
- The Jacuzzis remain closed.
- Masks must be worn at all times except when Swimming, eating or drinking.

Given the significantly reduced user capacity we intend to introduce a 2 hour per session limit on the amount of time you can spend at the Swimming Pool Complex. This will operate on a first come first served basis with the first 2 hour session starting at 6:30am with 8 sessions per day running through to a 9:30pm closure of the Swimming Pool Complex where the last session will be for 1 hour (8:30pm – 9:30pm).

Members will be issued with a coloured ticket(s) for each session which will be available from the Lifeguard Desk at the Pool entrance which you can pick up 15 minutes before the start of the next session. The intention is that the Swimming Pool Complex will be cleared by the end of each session and then members waiting with their tickets will be allowed access to the Pool for the next 2 hour session. Please be reminded that any Food and Beverage ordered from the Pool Bar must be consumed before the end of the allocated Pool session. I would add that until further notice NO GUESTS will be allowed to use the Swimming Pool Complex with the exception of Single Members who are permitted to bring one Guest at any time.

This is deemed to be the fairest way of handling the expected numbers of Members that will want to access the Pool, particularly over the upcoming long Easter holiday weekend.

A reminder that the Lifeguards (as well as members of Staff from the Sports Department and Food and Beverage Department) manage the Swimming Pool Complex and that operational requirements may change throughout the day, so please look to their direction at all times. Please also note that all other social distancing measures remain in place which means that until further notice we are still 4 persons per table in the F&B Outlets with 10pm closing. And, for the moment both our Childrens Playrooms and the Sauna and Steam Rooms will remain closed.

I hope you will have an enjoyable Easter break.
