














HISTORY OF HKFC

I ong Kong Football Club, established in 1886 by Sir James Haldane Lockhart, originated as a club for playing both Association and Rugby Football (now known as rugby union). Contrary to popular belief, it was not solely an association football (soccer) club. The Club's formation took place during a meeting at the Victoria Recreation Gymnasium on 12th February 1886. From its early days, HKFC swiftly emerged as a prominent centre for sporting activities in Hong Kong.

Over time, HKFC diversified its repertoire and expanded its range of ports to encompass lawn bowls, hockey, squash and more, attracting passionate athletes from diverse backgrounds. This expansion attracted passionate athletes from various backgrounds, establishing the Club as a diverse and inclusive sports community. With its unwavering dedication to athletic excellence and distinction as one of Hong Kong's oldest sports clubs, HKFC has successfully hosted numerous local and international sporting events. This has solidified its reputation as a premier sporting institution within the region.



DIFFERENT TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP AT HKFC



CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Any company or organisation wishing to be admitted as a Corporate Member can acquire a Corporate Subscribership, which allows one nominee per subscribership at any one time.

On purchase of a Corporate Subscribership a company becomes a Corporate Member and is entitled to nominate an individual and their immediate family, to enjoy the benefits of membership of the HKFC. This Corporate Subscribership is transferable subject to General Committee approval.

FULL (SPORTS PREFERRED) MEMBERSHIP

This category is designed for individuals who actively participate in sports and are willing to contribute to any of the Club's Sports Sections or Designated Sports Activities (DSA at the team level. The core sections include Rugby, Soccer, Lawn Bowls, Hockey, and Squash, while Netball has DSA status. Upon acceptance of an application, a 12-month temporary Associate Membership is granted, followed by the opportunity to convert to Full Membership. Full Membership entails a four-year commitment to playing and training for the relevant Sections/DSA, contingent upon achieving a suitable level of performance.

JUNIOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

The Junior Associate Membership gives young people under 28 years of age the opportunity to join the Club in their own right if they can play one of our core sports to a representative level. The core sections include Rugby, Soccer, Lawn Bowls, Hockey, and Squash, while Netball has DSA status. Each Sports Section, Designated Sports Activity or Society has specific requirements aligned to sporting ability that must be met by Junior Associate Members.

FULL (SOCIAL) MEMBERSHIP

This category has been suspended since 2001. Entitles a Member to all privileges of Full Membership including the ability to vote, propose individuals for membership and be elected to hold a position of Office at the Club.




MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

- Golf Debentures at Lotus Hill Golf Resort and Macau Golf & Country Club












The HKFC Hockey Section is a dynamic community with over 300 members registered with the Hong Kong Hockey Association. It fields eight men's teams, eight ladies' teams, three veterans' teams and five junior teams that compete in the HKHA League and cup competitions. The Club's all-weather international standard pitch and mini stadium host teams from Hong Kong and around the world for events like the Hong Kong Hockey Sixes. The Section prioritises youth development through its Junior Hockey program, providing coaching for all skill levels with the help of professional coaches and parent volunteers. HKFC has also played a significant role in establishing the Youth Hockey League in Hong Kong, nurturing players from grassroots to elite levels. The success of the Junior Hockey program is evidenced by the representation of its players at the national level.



LAWN BOWLS SECTION

The HKFC Lawn Bowls Section has been a fundamental part of the Hong Kong Football Club since 1932. With excellent indoor and outdoor facilities, including six rinks each. the Club welcomes local and international teams to enjoy the sport of bowls. The Section actively participates in HKLBA leagues and national competitions, promoting the game across different age groups. With around 200 dedicated members. the HKFC Lawn Bowls Section competes at various levels and hosts teams from Hong Kong in local leagues. Their accomplished bowlers have represented Hong Kong in prestigious global competitions, achieving remarkable success. Additionally, HKFC's outstanding facilities make it a preferred venue for hosting major international bowls tournaments.



RUGBY SECTION

The HKFC Rugby Section, established in 1886, has been instrumental in the development of rugby in Hong Kong. The renowned Hong Kong International Rugby Sevens, now a major global sporting event, had its humble beginnings at the Club in 1976. The Rugby Section fields nine teams in local league and cup competitions, attracting teams from across the region to its exceptional stadium. With a strong focus on youth development, the Mini and Youth Rugby programs nurture talent for the future. The Section's over 500 members include seven men's teams and two women's teams, consistently achieving success in league and cup competitions. Many players from the Rugby Section have represented Hong Kong at national levels, showcasing the Section's commitment to promoting the sport and developing elite players.

SOCCER SECTION

The HKFC Soccer Section has been an integral part of the Club since 1886. fostering the development of soccer in the city. Collaborating closely with the Hong Kong Football Association and other sporting bodies, the Club actively promotes the game and nurtures young talent. With over 300 members, the Soccer Section encompasses six competitive men's teams, a ladies' team, three social sides. and HKFC Youth and Junior teams. The Club's Junior Soccer program, catering to both members and non-members, attracts a participation of over 1,000 children and young individuals. The Club's floodlit stadium. featuring an all-weather pitch, hosts local league matches, cup competitions and international fixtures, including the renowned HKFC Soccer 7s tournament. The Section strives for excellence, community involvement and raising the standard of soccer in Hong Kong.



SQUASH SECTION

The HKFC Squash Section is a thriving community within the Club, comprising over 300 members and 33 teams in the Hong Kong Squash League. More than 1,500 players from local clubs participate in league matches at HKFC each season. The Section hosts a prestigious PSA World Squash event, attracting top-ranked players. With success in the league, including division titles and top-four playoff positions, the Club's Squash Section consistently excels. Members also compete in the Hong Kong Closed Championships, Masters Team competition and annual matches against local clubs. Internationally, they have achieved victories in the Asian 'Jumbo' Doubles tournaments and enjoy overseas tours combining competitive squash and social activities. HKFC Squash Section is dedicated to promoting squash as an elite sport and fostering a vibrant squash community in Hong Kong.

NETBALL DSA

The HKFC Netball Designated Sports Association (DSA) is a leading netball club in Hong Kong, featuring seven teams in the HKNA senior leagues and players representing Hong Kong at the national level. Matches are held on the Club's top-notch netball courts. The HKFC Junior Netball Academy promotes the sport among children, offering coaching and training for both members and non-members. With qualified coaches and dedicated team coaches, the Club emphasises skill development. The Netball DSA also arranges mixed social matches, hosts touring teams and welcomes international coaches. The growth of the Junior Netball Academy (JNA) reflects the rising interest in netball, with players progressing to the Hong Kong national U14 and U16 squads.



BADMINTON SOCIETY

The HKFC Badminton Society offers world-class badminton facilities and coaching for players of all levels and ages. The Society is dedicated to raising the standard of badminton at HKFC and in Hong Kong, participating in the HKBA league and hosting tournaments. With weekly club nights, coaching sessions and junior programmes led by renowned coaches, members have ample opportunities to improve their skills and enjoy both social and competitive badminton.

GOLF SOCIETY

The HKFC Golf Society, boasting 800 members, hosts monthly medal competitions, inter-society matches and international tours. Members enjoy exclusive access to Lotus Hill Golf Club and Macau Golf & Country Club through the Club's debentures with complimentary green fees. Maintaining a Hong Kong Golf Association handicap is mandatory, and adherence to golf etiquette is expected on the courses. The Society provides a thriving community for golf enthusiasts to connect and participate in exciting golfing experiences.



TENNIS SOCIETY

The HKFC Tennis Society has around 230 active members, promoting tennis among sports enthusiasts at the Club. Six all-weather floodlit courts on the rooftops of the Clubhouse provide opportunities for both recreational play and competitive participation in Hong Kong Tennis Association leagues. With teams competing in evening and daytime matches, the Society also organises tournaments throughout the year. Resident ex-professional tennis coaches offer individual and group coaching sessions, including junior development programmes and a dedicated junior league to nurture young talent.

SWIMMING AND TRIATHLON SOCIETY

The HKFC S&T Society provides a platform for competitive swimming, intensive training, technique enhancement and social activities related to swimming and triathlon. The Society organises swimming galas, open water events and triathlons. Training is provided for Olympic distance triathlons, and sessions focus on technique improvement. With 80+ adult members and 30+ iuniors, the Society welcomes new members over 16 who can swim 500m non-stop. Training sessions, coached by qualified instructors, are available on weekdays and weekends, including sessions for swimmers aged 8 to 15.





BOWLING INTEREST GROUP
















SPORTSMAN'S BAR
