

COVID-19 Preventative Measures

Dear Member,

Further to my communication of 20th February 2022, I am writing to update you on the Club's current policy in light of the current situation with Covid.

Firstly, subsequent to a number of preliminary positive infections of Staff causing us to take the decision to close, we will be reopening the Club on Saturday 26th February 2022 after taking the opportunity to deep clean the entire Club Premises.

Going forward we will adopt a policy of remaining open even if there are cases of infected Staff or Members/Guests, albeit with reduced services in line with extant Government regulations details of which are provided in the regular "Whats On" communications.

Every evening enhanced cleaning will take place of the Club Premises, and if we have any reports of infection from Staff or Members, then the affected areas will be subjected to further deep cleaning overnight.

We do not intend to advise Members every time there is an infection, given that we have taken medical advice and it is clear that whilst more contagious than past strains, Omicron is less virulent.

Please bear in mind that:

- (i) All Staff are double vaccinated, and currently undertaking their Booster shots.
- (ii) All Members and their Guests must swipe the Leave Home Safe Application and show proof of vaccination in order to gain entry to the Club, in line with Government regulations.

We will continually monitor the situation to ensure that the wellbeing of all Staff and Members/Guests is paramount, whilst balancing the objective to keep the Club open for the benefit of our Members.
